Patriot Day 2026 is on Friday, September 11, 2026, and marks 25 years since the September 11 attacks. The day remembers the nearly 3,000 people who died in New York City, the Pentagon, and aboard Flight 93.

A moment of silence is traditionally observed at 8:46 AM Eastern Daylight Time, matching the exact time the first plane struck the North Tower of the World Trade Center.

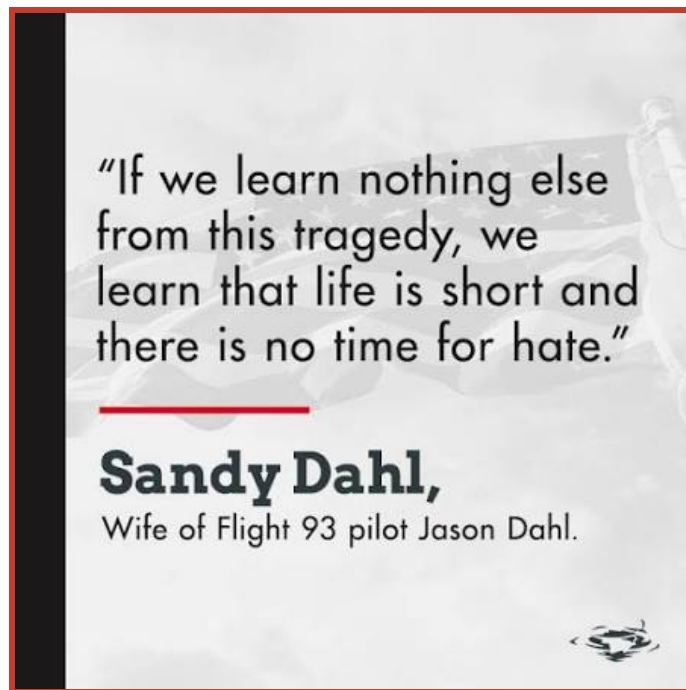
Patriot Day was first held in 2002 after a proclamation by President George W. Bush. In 2009, President Barack Obama rededicated it as both Patriot Day and a National Day of Service and Remembrance, inspiring Americans

to volunteer in their local communities in tribute to the individuals lost and injured.

"Our goal is to transform the 9/11 anniversary, for all time, into an annual moment of national reflection, unity and doing good in tribute to the 9/11 victims, their families, and the many first responders, recovery workers, volunteers, and military personnel who rose in service in response to the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks," said David Paine, the president and co-founder of 9/11 Day. "We want to reclaim the day."
