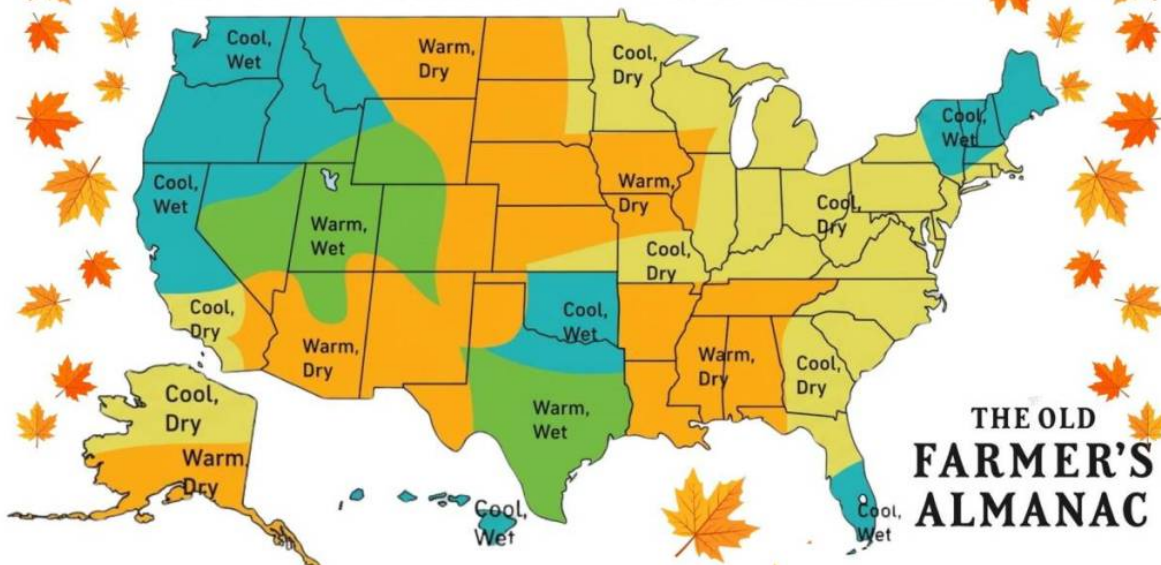




2026 FALL FORECAST



Fall is almost here, with the autumnal equinox marking the change of seasons.

The first official day of fall in 2026 is Tuesday, September 22. While Houston usually gets its first hints of fall in late September, reliably fall-like conditions don't tend to arrive until mid-to-late October.

The Farmer's Almanac predicts warmer-than-average weather in Southern Texas during the month of September and October. It expects September to begin broadly warm, with a more noticeable cool-down and increasingly frequent rain or storm systems by November. Throughout the season, the publication predicts above-average precipitation.

Warm and rainy weather creates severe health risks for unhoused people because wet clothing and high humidity prevent the body from cooling properly while causing dangerous skin breakdown and hypothermia even in mild temperatures. Continuous rain makes it nearly impossible to keep clothes, shoes, or bedding dry.

Thanks to your generous donations, the EAC is able to provide clients with rain ponchos and umbrellas to keep them dry on rainy days. And new and gently-used rolling suitcases are always in high demand as a means to keeping possessions safe and dry.

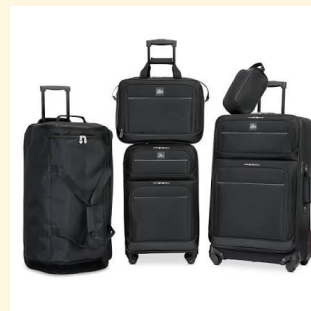
